On consideration of the Stipulation for Discipline by Consent Pursuant to
Alaska Bar Rule 22(h) filed on **December 4, 2025,**

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Stipulation¹ is accepted;
2. Jacob Sonneborn is suspended from the practice of law for 30 months,
with credit for time served on interim disciplinary suspension, and no
time stayed;
3. Before applying for reinstatement, Jacob Sonneborn must meet with
the Lawyers' Assistance Committee and follow all recommendations
of that committee;
4. Before applying for reinstatement, Jacob Sonneborn must make full
restitution of any amounts owed to the Lawyers' Fund for Client

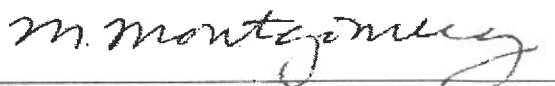
