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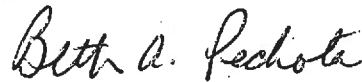
iii. provide evidence that he has satisfied all fines, orders of restitution, penalties and judgments arising from the malicious destruction of property in Idaho;

(d) If Mr. Stanford is reinstated to practice law in Alaska, he will be on probation for two years from the date of this court's reinstatement order. During the period of probation, Bruce F. Stanford will show compliance with his regimen of prescribed medication by providing reports to Bar Counsel from his treating physician at four-month intervals;

(e) During the terms of suspension and probation, if Mr. Stanford is convicted of a crime involving firearms or substance abuse, it will be grounds for the Bar Association to re-open this case to seek extension of the term of suspension.
