The Alaska Bar Association Disciplinary Board has filed its recommendation for discipline of Henry E. Graper, III, along with the findings, conclusions, and recommendations of the Area Hearing Committee, all submitted under Alaska Bar Rule 22(n). Graper has not filed an appeal from the Disciplinary Board's recommendations nor has he objected to the Disciplinary Board's recommendation for discipline. The reason for this discipline is that Graper committed criminal acts that reflect adversely on his fitness as a lawyer as detailed in the Committee's report.

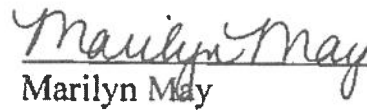
IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Disciplinary Board's findings, conclusions, and recommendation for discipline are **APPROVED**;
2. Henry E. Graper, III is suspended from the practice of law for at least a period of three years, commencing on August 15, 2011, the date of his interim suspension. The suspension shall continue until Graper has completed his criminal probation.
3. If Graper seeks reinstatement under Bar Rule 29, he must prove that he has completed his criminal probation, has maintained sobriety, has regularly attended support group meetings, has passed a reasonable medical test for substance abuse, and has not violated the conditions of his criminal probation.
