On consideration of the 9/7/07 findings, conclusions and recommendation of the disciplinary board under Alaska Bar Rule 22(n).

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Disciplinary Board's recommended discipline is **APPROVED**.
2. Frederick H. Hahn, V, is **SUSPENDED** from the practice of law for a period of two years and one day.
3. As a condition of applying for reinstatement to practice law, Mr. Hahn is required to reimburse the Bar Association for the expenses of retaining trustee counsel.
4. As a condition of applying for reinstatement under Alaska Bar Rule 29(c)(1), Mr. Hahn is additionally required to provide a complete medical release for medical records of all health care providers he has consulted or



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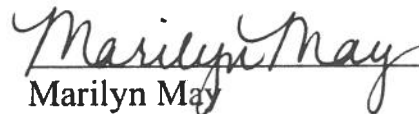
treated with from April 2006 to the date he files his petition for reinstatement.

5. As a condition of applying for reinstatement, and in view of the Supreme Court's authority under Alaska Bar Rule 16(c)(3) and Mr. Hahn's failure to respond to disciplinary grievances against him, he must pay the Bar Association \$1,000 in costs and attorney fees.

6. The period of suspension shall begin on **1/12/08**.
