This matter having come before the court for review of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Disciplinary Board of the Alaska Bar Association, pursuant to Alaska Bar Rule 22(r), and the court being advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. On full review of the record in this case, we AFFIRM and ADOPT the decision of the Disciplinary Board of the Alaska Bar Association.

2. Respondent Ranauld H. Jarrell is suspended from the practice of law in the State of Alaska for a period of four years, effective immediately.

3. Any application by Ranauld H. Jarrell for reinstatement to the practice of law in Alaska shall comply with all requirements of Alaska Bar Rule 29.

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4. Pursuant to Alaska Bar Rule 16(c)(3), respondent is ordered to pay to the Alaska Court System costs in the amount of \$18,414.47.¹
