This matter having come before the court on a referral of the decision and recommendation of the disciplinary board of the Alaska Bar Association, and the court being advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. On a full review of the record in this case, the decision of the disciplinary board of the Alaska Bar Association recommending that respondent JAMES F. PETERSON be ordered to reimburse Susan R. Fredricksen is AFFIRMED AND ADOPTED. Within 30 days of the filing date of this order JAMES F. PETERSON shall reimburse to Susan R. Fredricksen the amount of \$700, plus interest from March 18, 1982.

2. The decision of the disciplinary board of the Alaska Bar Association recommending that, should the respondent be reinstated from his suspension for non-payment of Bar membership dues and authorized to practice law, he be suspended from the practice of law for 30 days is also AFFIRMED AND ADOPTED. Any reinstatement of the respondent to the practice of law shall also be conditioned upon his passage of the Multi-state Professional Responsibility Examination.
