DECISION AND ORDER OF  
DISCIPLINARY BOARD

The Disciplinary Board of the Alaska Bar Association convened on September 7, 1990 to consider the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendations dated March 16, 1990 issued by the First Judicial District Area Hearing Committee sitting in this matter. This matter had previously come before the Board on June 5, 1990, but was tabled until the September meeting by the Board so that the parties could discuss a possible agreement as to sanction. Those discussions were not successful.

The Alaska Bar Association was represented by bar counsel Stephen J. Van Goor. The respondent was represented by Mark C. Choate. Both the respondent and his counsel participated by phone.

After hearing from bar counsel, respondent's counsel and the respondent, the Board retired to deliberate. On a motion by Jeffrey Feldman, seconded by Philip Volland, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the area hearing committee's

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findings of fact, and conclusions of law and so much of their recommendation as is contained in the first sentence of their recommendation.

Under Bar Rule 16(a)(5), the respondent is publically reprimanded by the Disciplinary Board for his misconduct.
