ORDER

The appeal of respondent Robert M. Beconovich came before the Disciplinary Board on June 3, 1992. After consideration of the arguments of counsel, the briefs and record before the Area Hearing Committee the Findings of Fact of the Committee are affirmed and adopted.

The Board further adopts the Committee's Conclusion of Law 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, and 7. Conclusion 5, requiring both a censure by the Supreme Court and public reprimand by the Board is rejected.

The Board hereby publicly reprimands respondent for his violation of DR 6-101(A)(3) - neglect of a legal matter entrusted to him.

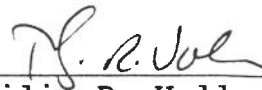
ORDER
