IT IS ORDERED:

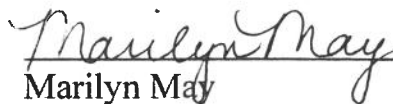
Reciprocal discipline is **IMPOSED** pursuant to Alaska Bar Rule 27(c) as follows:
