On consideration of the petition for rehearing filed on November 4, 1996,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The petition is GRANTED IN PART: The following sentence, at page 16 of the slip opinion, "Triem contributed to some of the delay by his late filings and numerous motions," is amended to read, "Triem, by moving for a more definite statement, was partially responsible for some of the prehearing delay." The petition is otherwise DENIED.

2. The Alaska Bar Association's request to clarify footnote 5 and change the caption of the case is GRANTED.

3. Opinion No. 4417 is withdrawn, and opinion No. 4443, reflecting the modifications noted in paragraphs 1 and 2 above, is issued today in its place.
