4. Respondent is required to pay the Bar Association's attorney fees and costs in this matter. The Bar Association shall file a motion for attorney's fees on or before **August 17, 2009**.

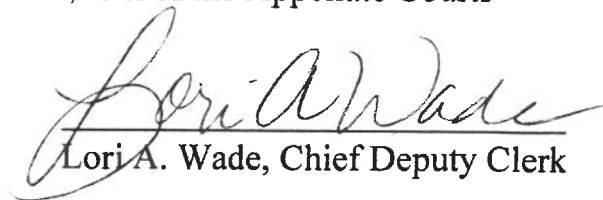
