On consideration of the findings, conclusions, and recommendation submitted by the Alaska Bar Association Disciplinary Board under Alaska Bar Rule 22(n) for this court's review pursuant to Alaska Bar Rule 22(r),

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Disciplinary Board's findings, conclusions and recommendation for discipline are **APPROVED**;
2. Dennis R. Acker is **DISBARRED** from the practice of law, effective immediately;
3. Dennis R. Acker's reinstatement to practice is subject to the following conditions:
 - (a) Mr. Acker must comply with Alaska Bar Rule 29(b) before seeking reinstatement;

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(b) Mr. Acker must make full restitution to the clients whose grievances are the subject of this disciplinary matter for funds lost and/or damages incurred as a result of his misconduct;

(c) Mr. Acker must make full restitution to the Alaska Bar Association's Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection of any monies paid to his clients as a result of his abandonment of his law practice;

(d) Mr. Acker must make full payment to Pamela Hershberger of the Fee Arbitration award made to her (or to the Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection maintained by the Bar, whichever is appropriate);

(e) Mr. Acker must establish that within the 12 months preceding his application for reinstatement he has completed 6 hours of continuing legal education on legal ethics to be approved by the Alaska Bar Association;

(f) Mr. Acker must establish that within the 12 months preceding his application for reinstatement he has completed 12 hours of continuing legal education on law office management to be approved by the Alaska Bar Association;

(g) Mr. Acker must take and pass the MPRE examination;

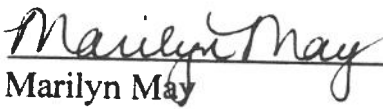
(h) Mr. Acker must establish a plan for the handling of client funds, with mandatory quarterly auditing and reporting to the Alaska Bar Association for a period of two years following reinstatement;

(I) Mr. Acker must reimburse the Alaska Bar Association for its costs incurred in these disciplinary proceedings.
