On consideration of the Alaska Bar Association Disciplinary Board's findings, conclusions, and recommendation, submitted for review under Bar Rule 22(r),

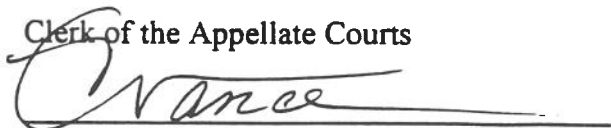
IT IS ORDERED:

1. Under Bar Rule 16 and in accordance with the recommendation of the Disciplinary Board Attorney George E. Weiss is disbarred from the practice of law in Alaska effective immediately.

2. To be eligible to apply for reinstatement under Bar Rule 29, Weiss must comply with the conditions recommended by the Disciplinary Board: a) full restitution to all clients whose cases are included in the committee report; b) take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Exam; c) attend an Alaska CLE on law office management; d) obtain an examination by a psychiatrist or psychologist approved by bar counsel and follow all treatment recommendations of the examiner; and e) comply with any requests for action or information from any future hearing committee considering any future petition for reinstatement.
