O R D E R

IT APPEARING that by order of the Supreme Court of the State of Alaska, dated October 19, 1984, Robert C. Blackford has been disbarred from the practice of law in the State of Alaska effective immediately.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. THAT Robert C. Blackford is disbarred from the practice of law before the United States District Court for the District of Alaska.
2. THAT within five days of the date of this order Robert C. Blackford may show good cause in writing, if any he has, why the order contained in paragraph one above shall not remain in full force and effect pending further order of this Court or the Supreme Court of the State of Alaska.

3. THAT the Clerk of Court mail to Robert C. Blackford at his last known address a certified copy of this order, which mailing shall constitute proper notice.
