JUDGMENT and COMMITMENT

On this 27th day of June, 1956, came the attorney for the government and the defendant appeared in person and propria persona; the Court advised the defendant of his right to counsel and asked him whether he desired to have counsel appointed by the Court, and the defendant thereupon stated that he waived the right to the assistance of counsel.

IT IS ADJUDGED that the defendant has been convicted upon his plea of guilty of the offense of embezzlement by attorney as charged; and the Court having asked the defendant whether he has anything to say why judgment should not be pronounced, and no sufficient cause to the contrary being shown or appearing to the Court,

IT IS ADJUDGED that the defendant is guilty as charged and convicted.

IT IS ADJUDGED that the defendant is hereby committed to the custody of the Attorney General or his authorized representative for imprisonment for a period of Six (6) months, said sentence to commence and begin on the 27th day of June, 1956.

IT IS ADJUDGED that execution of said sentence of imprisonment is hereby suspended for a period of Three (3) years from this date, and the defendant is placed on probation for a period of Three (3) years, conditions of probation being as follows:

(1) Defendant shall report to Probation Officer as directed.

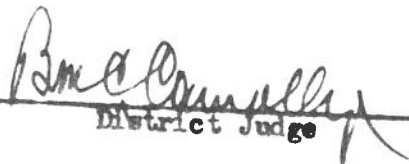
(2) Defendant shall make full and complete restitution to his client within Four (4) months from this date.

(3) Defendant shall immediately surrender his license to practice law in the Territory of Alaska or anywhere else the defendant is licensed to practice.

(4) Defendant shall not leave the jurisdiction of this Court without permission of the Court.

IT IS ORDERED that the Clerk deliver two certified copies of this Judgment and Commitment to the Probation Officer, one copy of which the Probation Officer shall deliver to the defendant.
