On consideration of the stipulation for discipline by consent last dated April 5, 2011, filed for review by the Supreme Court pursuant to Alaska Bar Rule 22(h).

### IT IS ORDERED:

1. Christopher N. Pallister is suspended from the practice of law for a period of two years and one day.

(a) As a condition of applying for reinstatement to practice under Alaska Bar Rule 29, Mr. Pallister is required to coordinate with the Alaska Bar Association CLE department to select 9 hours of continuing legal education programs appropriate for his area of practice. He must also complete six hours of continuing legal education in the field of ethics.

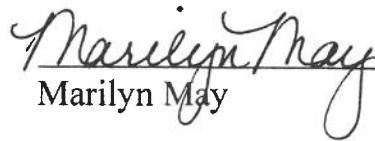
2. Mr. Pallister is publicly censured for his failure to answer the grievance. Mr. Pallister will be notified by the clerk of the time and date of his appearance before the Court to receive the public censure.

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3. As a condition of applying for reinstatement, Mr. Pallister must pay the Bar Association \$1,000.00 in costs and attorneys fees.
