On consideration of the documents filed by the Alaska Bar Association on March 12, 2008, evidencing a conviction in *United States of America vs. James Clark*, 3:08-cr-00023-JWS on a charge of Conspiracy to Commit Honest Services Mail and Wire Fraud (18 U.S.C. 371), respondent's brief regarding interim suspension dated April 11, 2008, the Bar Association's brief regarding interim suspension dated April 23, 2008, and respondent's reply brief regarding interim suspension dated April 25, 2008:

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Respondent James F. Clark is placed on interim suspension from the practice of law in Alaska, effective immediately.
2. Disciplinary proceedings against James F. Clark will proceed as required by Bar Rule 26(j).
3. The Bar Association shall provide the notices required by Bar Rule 28.
4. James F. Clark shall provide the notices required by Bar Rule 28(a) and comply with all other provisions of Bar Rule 28.

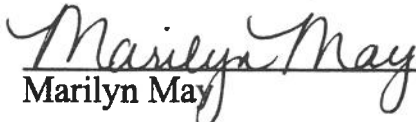
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5. James F. Clark may not practice law until reinstated by order of this court.
